I guess the Visalia YMCA has been skate oriented for a while now with the likes of a guy named Bobby Goodsby working for them. For the past two years the YMCA has hosted a summer camp in various regions of California for the avid skater, but now they've decided to promote the art right in their own backyard. For summer camp 85 a veteran verticalist named Chuck Gillette was drafted to help finish the 11 ft. high, 24 ft. wide pig and what a tight ship he ran. With the experience of building the Ark I under his belt and now the proud owner of the Ark II he was again drafted to do his thing to a large patch of grass, in the middle of a jogging track, around back of the YMCA. "Think Big!" was the cry and that he did.

The ramp is 40 ft. wide with a low side and a high side.

The low side is 16 ft. wide with 1/2 ft. of vertical and the high side has a whole ft. of vertical with a two ft. vertical tombstone. The transitions are 9 ft. and there are 2 roll-in channels. The coping is one of the best things about the structure because it is steel and it has a sautered escalator from low to high. The place has been demo-ed, sessioned, contested, and recently got a new set of clothes - masonite style.

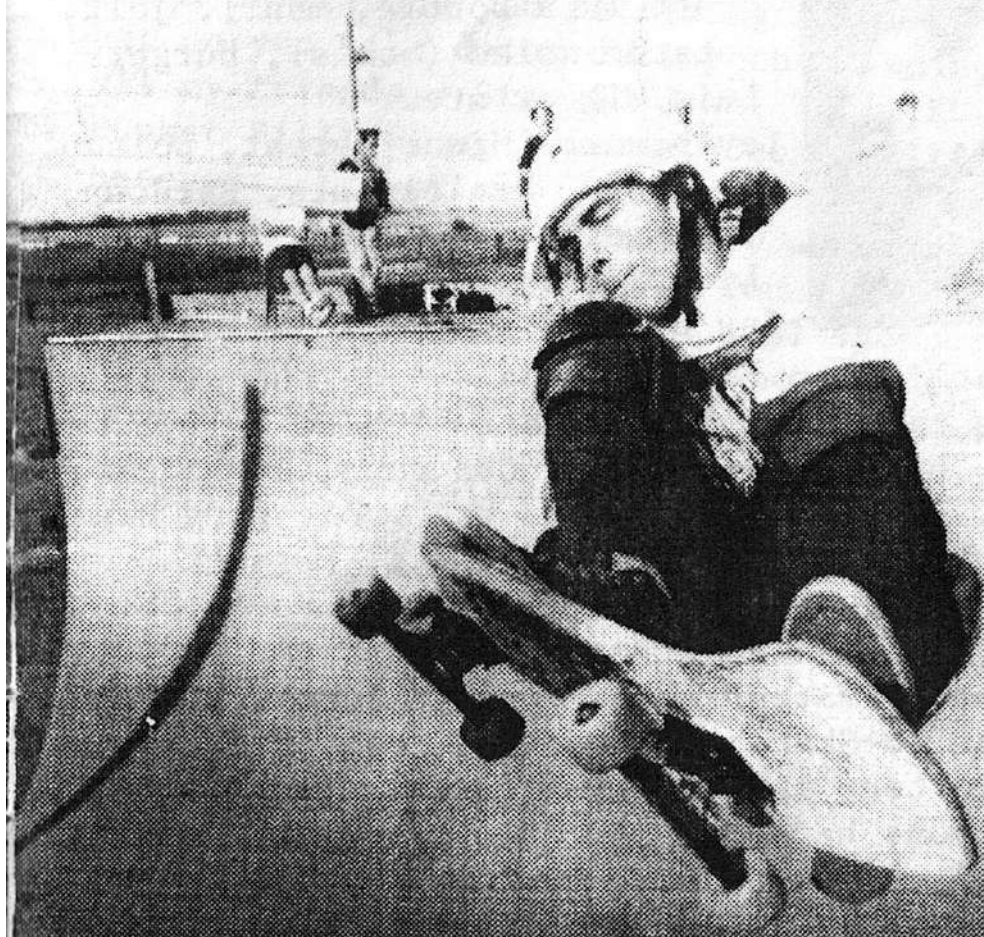


SACRAMENTO

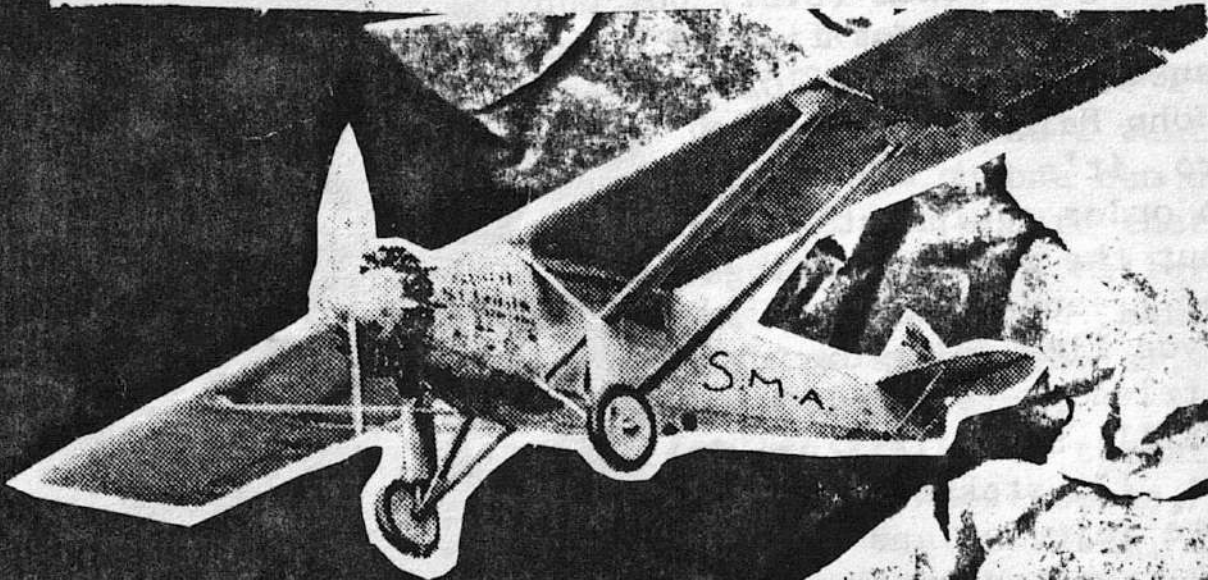

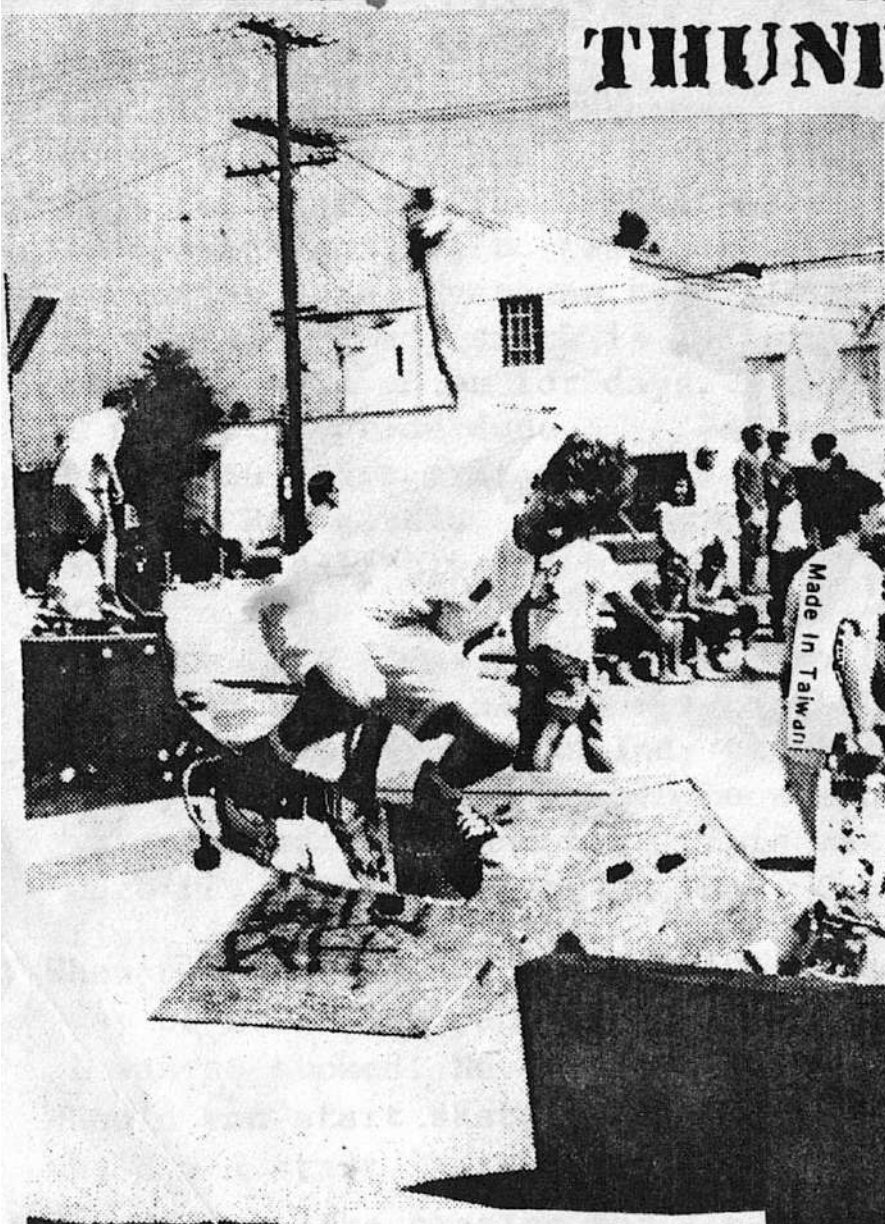
